Every day, we stand with Chicago's most vulnerable residents, offering the stability, dignity, and care they need to move from crisis to possibility.

From street outreach and prevention to rapid re-housing, permanent supportive housing, behavioral health care, and clinical case management, our comprehensive, evidence-based programs are changing lives—and systems.

And the impact goes beyond individual lives: every \$1 invested in Renaissance generates \$3.77 in public savings by reducing the burden on hospitals, shelters, emergency services, and the criminal justice system.

We touch thousands of vulnerable Chicagoans...

In 2024, Renaissance helped more than 4,300 unhoused and housing insecure people and families throughout Chicago:

2,404

individuals received resources to prevent eviction and homelessness

648

participants lived in the agency's permanent supportive housing, including 71 families

216

people were rapidly re-housed, including 42 families

523

people living on the streets and in shelters were connected to housing, health care, and/or behavioral services

533

individuals received initial screening and referrals for housing and services

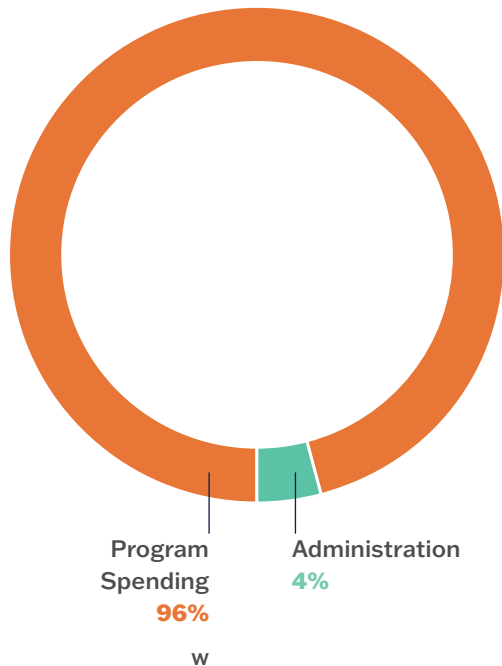

Expenses



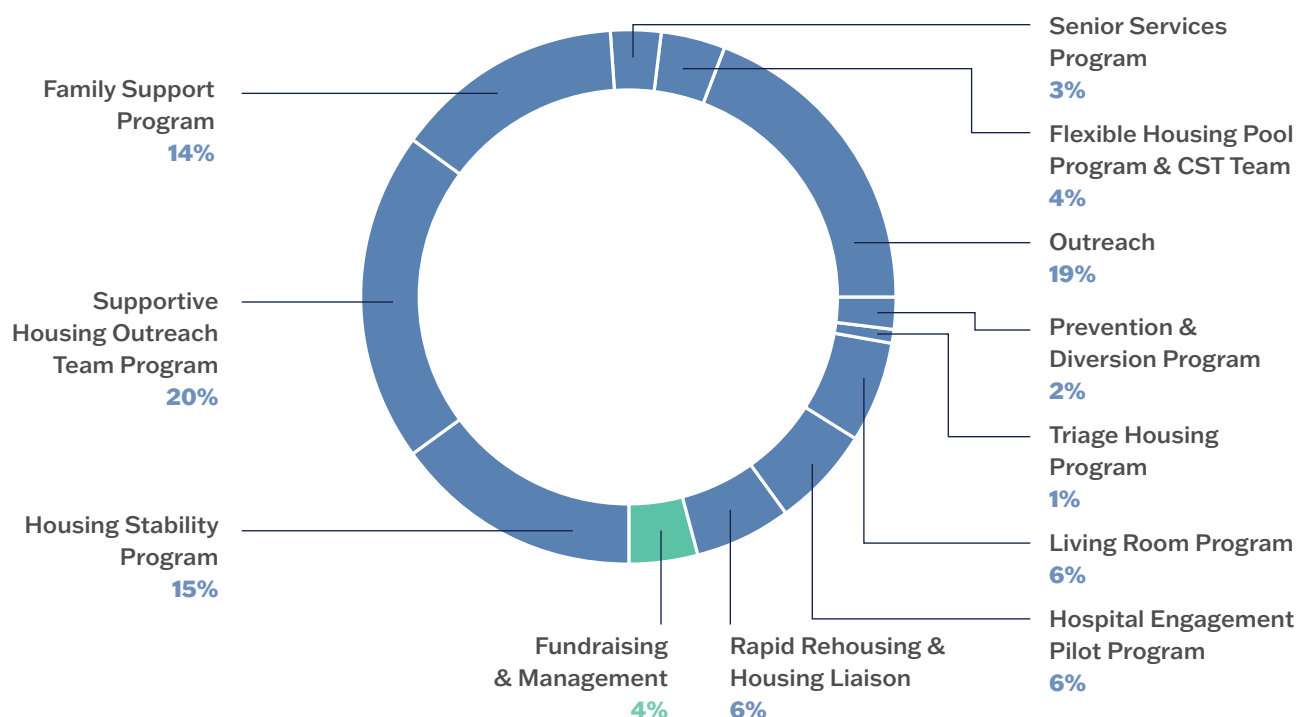
