In 2024, Renaissance helped more than 4,300 unhoused and housing insecure people and families throughout Chicago:

2,404

individuals received resources to prevent eviction and homelessness

648

participants lived in the agency's permanent supportive housing, including 71 families

216

people were rapidly re-housed, including 42 families

523

people living on the streets and in shelters were connected to housing, health care, and/or behavioral services 533

individuals received initial screening and referrals for housing and services




